We commenced operation with our first official gathering February 2011.

- To offer professional services which will enhance life giving skills and foster self worth, enabling people to regain confidence in their ability to live a rewarding and fulfilling life.

What we have achieved and Future

Established as a (not for profit) Charity in 2014 we now have members from all churches and community volunteers working together at our "Good Shepherd Welcome Centre" Kiama, where we serve free hot meals to the needy and lonely every week, whilst offering friendship, love and support.

On an additional day each week we offer indoor activities to the community to encourage mind and body wellness and social interaction.

We meet every 3 months for Spiritual Nurturing and Friendship with other Christians and like-minded community members.
Fundraising events are held throughout the year.

AIMS FOR THE FUTURE

Our aim is to Establish Emergency Relief accommodation in South of Wollongong to Nowra for those less fortunate; a shelter for the Homeless; assistance for a needy family in difficult circumstances whether through loss of employment, sickness or victims of natural disaster; to welcome Indigenous Refugees and People with a Disability, giving assistance where possible.
